Supply Update: Tomatoes may be slightly more backwards in colour this week, especially the end fruit from trusses for the vine codes.

UK Grower Update: The ongoing wet weather is causing problems for a lot of UK growers as nutrients are leaching from the soil, growth is reduced and harvest is becoming very difficult due to waterlogging. Open field grown products such as leafy salads and babyleaf have an increased risk of soil, weeds and insects inside so please be extra vigilant during washing and preparation.

New Season UK Red and White cabbage in stock this week. The whites will have a greener cast while still immature. UK greens including Chinese leaf, Bok Choi, Savoy cabbage and spring cabbage are still good.
