Tomatoes & Peppers: Inconsistent spells of high heat mixed with cooler, dull weather is affecting growth and quality. We are seeing some tenderness in fruit and a mixture of both forward and backwards batches coming through. **Lamb's Lettuce:** Spells of very changeable weather in France since July are adversely affecting the quality and shelf-life of

the harvested crop with a high amount of wastage after shipping. Improvements towards the end of the month are expected as hardier varieties start to come through.

Supply Update: Nectarines are now finished. UK Courgettes will be finishing this week and although quality is good, sizes will be on the larger side. We will see a mixture of both UK and Spanish deliveries before moving to all Spanish next week.
