Following a generally poor Summer, we are now crossing over in to Autumn. This is the second of our main seasonal shoulders during the year and as a result we will start to see Northern European crops wind down due to the shorter daylight hours and cooler, duller weather.

Tomatoes : Inconsistent spells of high heat mixed with cooler, dull weather is affecting growth and quality. We are seeing some tenderness in tomatoes and a mixture of both forward and backwards colour batches depending on country of origin. Beef & intense especially may have greener shoulders. Ripening affected fruit further (were possible) before release. Melons: Honeydew taste is good but skin finish has become quite scruffy again with a lot of sugar spotting. We are also having to utilise some 7 count Watermelons so singles may be towards the lower end of the weight specification this week. Seasonal Update: UK courgettes now finished. Starting supply of Moroccan cherry tomatoes from end of this week. Pumpkins will start supply from next week with pre-order chocolate and toffee apples to follow towards the end of October.
