Country of origin changes: Almost all stock of tomatoes is now new season Moroccan in origin – still odd Belgian and Dutch but quality is good. Fancy leaf (Oak & Lollo) still waiting to move over to Spanish origin. Strawberries have now moved over to North African supply.

Ungraded Mushrooms: Please note that the specification for this code includes both white and chestnut varieties. Brazil: Brazil who are one of our main suppliers for melons and limes are currently experiencing a severe spring heatwave in the South of the country. Although no quality issues have been reported by our growers as yet, we are monitoring the situation closely.

Seasonal: Peeled chestnuts 05999, 'shell on' chestnuts 76912 and loose Brussels Sprouts continue to be available to order.
