Seasonal Changes:

UK Asparagus has finished early this year due to early hot dry weather. UK carrot is at the end of season with the last of the Scottish crop with imports due mid June to tide us over to the new English harvest. UK Strawberries and fancy leaf continue to be very good. Last full week of imported Broccoli, this should be full UK by WC 9th June. Due to the recent hot weather followed by rain, UK growers are reporting an increase in weeds, insects, plant material & soil in crops so please be extra vigilant when washing both baby leaf and whole head lettuces to remove any field debris
